#### **NAFSA E-LEARNING CANCELLATION POLICY**

# PLEASE READ THE NAFSA E-LEARNING PARTICIPANT USER AGREEMENT AND SIGN THE AGREEMENT ON PAGE 2.

Before you register for a NAFSA e-Learning course for the first time, carefully review the conditions of usage displayed in the scroll-box below. If you wish to proceed with the registration, you must click the "I Accept" button, which indicates your acceptance of the NAFSA e-Learning Participant User Agreement and its terms and conditions set forth below. If you do not wish to accept this Agreement, do not proceed with the registration or click on the button. After clicking the "I Accept" button, you will be taken to a page with a link to the NAFSA e-Learning home page. You will go through this step only at the time of registration for a course. On subsequent visits, you will go directly to the NAFSA e-Learning home page after logging in.

#### **BACKGROUND**

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions governing the use of the Training by Participant. By becoming a participant user of the Site, clicking the "I Accept" button on this registration page and using the Training, you are entering into a binding and enforceable agreement to be bound by all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
